

# England Netball Affiliation Fees, 2009-10



Subscriptions shall be payable on and from 1 September and must be paid by 31 December, which latter date shall be the due date for the purposes of Article 9. <b>College / University</b> – unlimited number of Registered Participants who are students in full-time education, plus one lecturer	£150.70
<b>Junior League</b> – A Junior Netball League established for players under statutory school leaving age.	£86.70 - £195.10
<b>Youth Club</b> – unlimited number of Registered Participants 21 yrs and under, and including one nominated leader over 21.	£86.70 - £195.10

## Tiering Groups

To maintain the simplified and fairer fee structure, from 1 September 2009 the 'group' fees will continue be tiered according to the number of participants within the group. This covers the Armed Services Netball Associations, Associate Members, Junior League and Youth Club Categories as follows :
