Associate Member – A company, association or sports club with an interest in Netball; a person, club, college or university in a country or state where no National Netball Association exists.	£91.90 - £216.80
Junior League – A Junior Netball League established for players under statutory school leaving age.	£86.70 - £195.10
College / University – Unlimited number of Registered Participants who are students in full-time education, plus one lecturer.	£150.70
Youth Club – Unlimited number of Registered Participants 21 yrs and under, and including one nominated leader over 21.	£86.70 - £195.10
Armed Service Netball Association	£91.90 - £216.80

Tiering Groups

To simplify the fee structure and to make it fairer, from 1 September 2009 the 'group' fees will be tiered according to the number of participants within the group. This would cover the Associate Member, Armed Services Netball Associations, Youth Clubs and Junior League Categories as follows :

Benefits

Personal Accident Insurance

Affiliated Group members of England Netball are insured for "Silver Cover" Personal Accident Insurance. This will provide cover for participants whilst taking part in approved Netball activities for:

Personal Accident – Cover includes Capital Benefits; Emergency Dental Expenses; Broken Bones

Group members must agree to keep a register of all participants at matches, training sessions, etc, for a period of at least three years. This register must be available for England Netball to view at any time. On receipt of payment, the England Netball Insurance Certificate is sent to each club.
